Solidary visit to war refugees in the park next to the Central Bus Station

June 14th 2016

Women in Black activists Staša Zajović, Mirko Medenica and Violeta Đikanović on June 14th 2016, visited war refugees from the Middle East in the park next to the Central Bus Station in Belgrade.

This time there were a lot of refugees, mainly families with young children, primarily from Afghanistan. After a long time there were also a lot of people from Syria.

We met a family from the north of Syria, who is traveling with five children. They are traveling two months already, through Turkey and Bulgaria. Their idea is to get to Germany. Unlike most refugees they have passports.

We also talked with the woman from Afghanistan who is with her son and daughter also headed to Germany. Another family from Homs ... We were told that tomorrow they will try to go to Hungary.

There were plenty of men in groups and all in all it seems that refugees comes in large numbers and that nothing can stop them...

Many refugees are afraid to be photographed for obvious reasons. Therefore, this time we made very few photos.
