## Visits war refugees from the Middle East in Adaševci

March 25<sup>th</sup>, 2016

On March 25<sup>th</sup>, 2016 Violeta Djukanovic and Mirko Medenica, activists of Women in Black, visited a refugee center in Adaševci near Šid. We shared a fruit, milk, biscuits and toiletries with the families we already know from previous visits and we handed the rest to the OM organization, they continued with the work performed by REMAR, who left Adasevci.

We didn't see police in and around the camp. We toured the whole camp, and no one asked us anything. We noticed that a shower room was installed. Showering is possible in the three terms each day. The problem is due to a small amount of hot water, and it is not possible to get more than a couple of people bathe in one term.

Not far from those shower rooms, we saw that the workers were building a facility, which will be a bathroom. In an interview with the refugees, we found out that conditions have not changed, they are still the most troubled by uncertainty, no one is saying anything to them. They complained about the food, because it is already 20 days that they were in the camp and for lunch they always get a can of tuna.

A pregnant woman, who is nine months pregnant has told us that she was examined by a doctor in the camp and will be examined again in a few days. She said that there is nothing of the things that are necessary for a future baby, clothes, toiletries... They also told us that they lack clothes for children, they received only a jacket and that children do not have pants, shirts to change ... we saw many children who were playing all over the camp.
